We were approached by a teacher from Willsboro who asked if we would be willing to send her to the National Council of Teachers of English annual conference. We discussed the idea moving forward of having guidelines for such a request.  We will allow policy board members and instructors to request funds for Professional Learning. We looked at the old Mini-Grant application and started to talk about moving forward. Teacher Centers cannot just write checks to districts, so applications will be looked at internally and the NCTRC will decide what we want to fund moving forward.

At the last Policy Board meeting it was decided that the Personnel Sub Committee will reconvene to plan steps moving forward to hiring a new director when Denise retires in 2026. Committee volunteers will be Jeanette, Cindy and Angie.

Denise asked the group if they would be interested in doing a Self-Study one afternoon in April. Whoever can come will be provided lunch and half day sub pay for their district. Denise will send out a form to pick some dates for the month. Tuesdays and Thursdays work best for everyone.

Kim Wilfore from RENY came to share scholarship information with the board. She is asking for help getting out the word about the opportunity. Denise will share with the members and they can forward it if they wish. The information was already posted on the website, but the board would like there to be a disclaimer on the website that makes it clear that the NCTRC is not affiliated with RENY and information/questions should be forwarded to RENY.
